

1st Quarter Common Assessments

FAQ - Students

1. What if I do not have a computer with a web camera?
 - Students may use a cell phone or other device with a camera and microphone.
2. Can I complete my assessment earlier than scheduled?
 - Tests must be completed on the scheduled day and during the scheduled period unless previous arrangements are made with the teacher.
3. Who do I call if I need technical help during the assessment?
 - Contact your teacher during the test time via the WebEx chat.
4. How do I access my reference sheet (allowed on specific assessments only)?
 - Face-to-face – your teachers will provide
 - Seminole Connect - will be emailed to your school email address the morning of the test
5. Can I use notes or other resources during this assessment?
 - No, this assessment must be taken without the help of another person or use of notes or other materials. This assessment measures your progress mastering the standards taught during the first quarter. Resources other than a calculator and/or reference sheets (on specific tests only) may not be used.
6. How do I access my assessment?
 - On the day of the assessment, your teachers will email instructions and a testing ticket to you. The subject line will say Q1 Test. Your ticket and directions will look something like this:

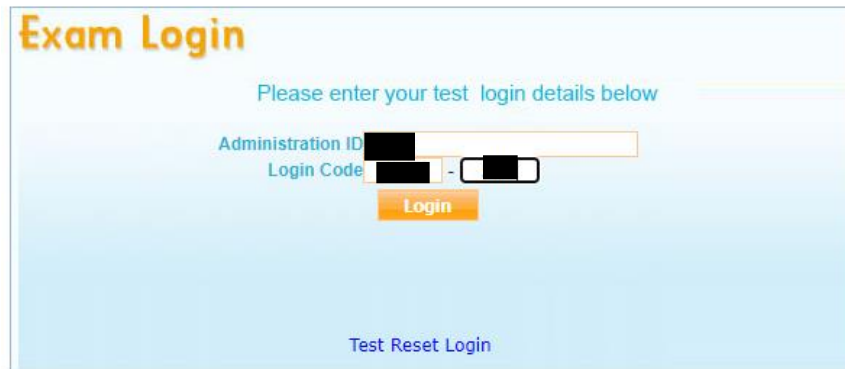
