- For **HHS courses**, please use this link to request a change. Please keep in mind that, at this time, we cannot change students who are scheduled for Intensive Reading or CARPD courses.
- To replace an HHS course with an **SCVS course**, there are two parts: first, please submit a request on the <u>SCVS site</u>. Second, request a change to the Hagerty schedule using the link in bullet number one. Students should note if they prefer an on-campus virtual lab or off-campus. If off-campus, please note the period/s requesting off. If your student is an incoming ninth grader, please also update your SCVS account to reflect Hagerty so that our counselors will be able to see the request.
- **Dual Enrollment:** School counselors are not contracted over the summer so please make sure your student schedules an appointment with their school counselor before the end of April to get dual enrollment in order. Students should visit this site to get basic information and bring the appropriate forms to the counselor meeting.

Schedule changes will be VERY limited in the fall. The deadline to request changes for the next school year is May 17, 2024.

Hagerty Journalism: Last weekend, the school publication staffs were recognized at the National Scholastic Press Association spring convention in Kansas City. Both the literary magazine and the yearbook received Pacemaker Finalist awards, give to top publications nationally. The news website received a Pacemaker, only one of 12 sites nationally to receive the award. In addition, Nadia Knoblauch, who became the state journalist of the year last month, was names as a national finalist for student journalist of the year.
