Principal's Message August 3, 2023

I hope that you and your family enjoyed the Thanksgiving vacation last week. I hope that our students had some time to disconnect, rest, and spend quality time with their families and are ready to make the final push to the end of the semester. There are only two and a half weeks left until we get to winter break. Please remember that we have three half days of school on December 18th, 19th, and 20th. Students will finish their exams on these days at 11:15 am and the busses will leave campus at 11:45 am. Students who drive, have rides, or walk home are allowed to leave at 11:15 on these days if they choose to do so. Please do not plan on coming in and picking up your student early as our students will be taking their exams throughout the campus and some exams take longer than others. Students can wait until 11:15 to be dismissed. I have attached the exam schedule for you to review with your student(s).

This is also the time of year when I start receiving requests for students to take their exams early because families have scheduled vacations to begin prior to the start of winter break. I DO NOT approve these requests. Students who miss their exams because they are absent from school can follow the normal attendance and make-up work procedures when they return to school in January. Students can schedule a time to take their exams with their teachers when they return and final grades can be changed at that time to reflect student performance on the exams. Teachers will input a zero into the gradebook until the student makes up his/her exam.
