Principal's Message February 16, 2024

I would like to welcome our new School Safety Guard, Sherell Green to campus. Ms. Green started working with us a couple of weeks ago and her primary responsibilities will be to monitor the student parking lot throughout the day. As a reminder, we have sold out of available parking spaces. I understand that many of you drive by our campus in the morning or afternoon and see lots of available parking spaces, however, our lot is full in the middle of the school day as many of our students only have classes on campus during that time. Please be mindful of the following expectations for parking on campus:

- 1. All vehicles that are parked in a colored parking space must have the proper parking pass displayed.
- 2. Only visitors should park in visitor parking. If a student is caught parking in a visitors parking space, then disciplinary consequences will be applied.
- 3. Students are required to park in the parking lot that is assigned to them by the color of their parking pass.
- 4. We do not recommend or encourage students parking their vehicles in surrounding neighborhoods. While we do not have any jurisdiction over these areas, we have encouraged residents to contact their Homeowner's Association and work with the Sheriff's Department if there is parking in their neighborhood that is in violation of law.
- 5. Hagerty High School has the right to tow vehicles that are parked without valid parking passes to protect the safety and security of our campus.
