1. Students need to request as many electives as possible. Electives are not scheduled according to preference; they are requests only. Instead, they are dictated by the computer when schedules are generated, therefore please request many classes you would be interested in taking.
2. We build our schedule around the choices students are making now! We can't accommodate significant schedule changes once this has been built. Teacher staffing and number of sections available are critical in meeting the needs of as many students as we can.
3. Off campus classes must be taken either at the beginning of the day or end of the day. WE do not build our master schedule around students planning on taking classes off campus. The classes will be scheduled throughout the day based on the needs of our campus.
