Principal's Message March 1, 2024

Parents of seniors:

I want to remind everyone of the changes that have been made district wide regarding credit recovery and seniors. This year seniors who fail a second semester class that is required for graduation WILL NOT be able to recover the missing credit in the weeks leading into graduation. Instead, they MUST attend summer school in order to earn the missing credit(s). Students who do not meet the graduation requirements WILL NOT be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony with the rest of their class in May. If they complete the graduation requirements during the summer, then they will be able to participate in the summer graduation ceremony in July.

Parents can monitor their child's academic progress and attendance by using Skyward Family Access. Please communicate with your child's teacher(s) if they are struggling academically so that we can work together to develop a plan for academic success. The third quarter will only account for 50% of the student's grade for the semester. The 4th quarter moves quickly, especially for seniors. Now is the time to take corrective action so that we can celebrate the graduation of all of our seniors in May!
