On April 2nd all 11th grade students will have the opportunity to participate in a presentation by the Seminole County Sheriff's Office that will share resources and expertise in the field of substance use and mental health. As you all know, we witness the impact of substance use and mental health challenges on our youth, families, and members of our community daily. In a proactive response, the Sheriff's office has partnered with the SAFE Project (Stop the Addiction Fatality Epidemic), and Rise Together and has coordinated a high school presentation for Hagerty High School. The key focus will be to break the silence and empower youth to make pro-health choices. The presentation will start at 12:45 PM and will be an hour long.
