Principal's Message November 10, 2023

This past week was Holocaust Education Week in the state of Florida. This week coincides with the anniversary of Kristallnacht, which was a major turning point in the persecution of European Jews by the Nazi regime. Because the anniversary of this event falls during the second week of November each year, schools throughout the state of Florida focus on education to prevent the violent ramifications of prejudice, racism, and stereotyping. This is a time where we use the history of anti-Semitism and the catastrophe of the Holocaust to reflect upon what it means to be a responsible and respectful person, to encourage tolerance, and to nurture and protect our own democratic institutions. This week, we made a couple of announcements recognizing the importance of this week and asked our social studies teachers to include one lesson about the Holocaust.

I will not be putting out an update next week, so this is the last one before Thanksgiving vacation. I hope that the upcoming vacation allows your student to disconnect and refresh so that they can come back for the final three and a half weeks ready to finish the semester strong.
