Principal's Message October 13, 2023

We have reached the end of the 1st 9-weeks. As a reminder, our students do not have school on Monday. It is a teacher workday. Teachers must submit final grades for students by Wednesday, October 18th at the end of the day. The student's first quarter exam in each class will account for 20% of their final grade. The student's first quarter grade will make up 50% of their overall semester grade, which is the grade that will be reflected on their transcript. If a student was absent and missed an exam, then they need to arrange a time with their teacher to make up the test as soon as possible. Teachers will be able to change a student's final grade once the exam has been taken.

Our seniors took the SAT during school this past Wednesday. Next week all 9th-11th grade students will be taking the PSAT. 9th grade students will take their test on Tuesday, 10th grade students on Wednesday, and 11th grade students on Thursday. Please make sure your child checks their SCPS email account to find their testing location. The test is digital this year.

Finally, all tardies will reset to zero at the start of the second quarter. Therefore, students will all receive three warnings. Students who do not have class in the morning are responsible for knowing when there are changes in our bell schedule and being in class on time.

Picture day retakes: Wednesday, Oct. 18 is PHOTO RETAKE DAY. Retakes are tentatively in the wrestling room.

- Because of PSAT and Wednesday block scheduling, the retake schedule will be:
 - 9th grade 4th period
 - 0 11th grade 7th period
 - 10th grade 6th period (to accommodate PSAT testing)
- Yearbook staff members will come to every class, every period to get the appropriate grade level students who need a retake.
- Students need a retake if:
 - They missed the first picture day
 - They ordered pictures and do not like them (bring them to the camera on retake day)
 - The first picture is scary, and you want another shot
- When students enter the wrestling room (through the courtyard entrance), they will get their card, stand for the camera, get a time stamped pass back to class, and exit through the far exit.
- Students should be out of class for less than 10 minutes.
- Students who are not on campus during their grade's listed period will need to come to the camera whenever they can during the day.
