Principal's Message October 27, 2023

So far, we have had a fantastic Homecoming Week! Last night's pep rally was a huge success, and we had almost 500 students attend movie night. I am looking forward to seeing everyone tonight at the football game. Our bleachers have cleared inspection, so we are ready to host a big crowd! Saturday night's dance will begin at 7:00 and will end at 10:00. We sold out of our 1750 tickets on Monday. Tickets will not be available at the door. There will be long lines to get through security prior to entering the dance and traffic will be backed up on Lockwood, so please plan accordingly.

We have a lot of students who are not serving their detentions for being tardy to class. Students receive three warnings in Minga prior to be assigned to detention. When a student receives a Minga tardy pass it is their responsibility to log into Minga to see if they have a consequence. Minga will also be sending automated emails to parents when their child is tardy to class. We will not reschedule detention for a student. If a student misses their detention, then it will escalate to a Saturday school. Remember, students can log into Minga either through the app on their phones or through Clever. We will remind students of this on campus, but it is also helpful to us if you also remind them at home!

AP School Honor Roll: Hagerty High School received an award from the College Board this past week. Hagerty was given Gold status on the 2023 AP Honor Roll. We also received the AP Access Award. The AP Honor Roll measures three things: College Culture, College Credit, and College Optimization. Last year, 65% of our students took at least one Advanced Placement Class. 54% of our students passed one of their AP tests by earning a score of 3 or higher. Finally, 25% of our class took at least five AP classes during their four years of high school. The AP Access Award recognizes that we are providing all students the chance to participate in AP, including students of underrepresented populations. We are very proud of our students, faculty, staff, and community.

Fall Sports: Our fall sports teams are all starting postseason competition. Congratulations to our boys and girls golf team who both qualified for regional competition. Our boys bowling team won the district championship and will head to the state tournament next week. Cami Sanguinetti of our girls bowling team qualified for the state tournament as an individual. Noah Stasik won the district diving championship and will be competing in regionals as an individual. Finally, congratulations and good luck to our girls' volleyball team who will be competing tomorrow afternoon in the regional semi-finals when they host Timber Creek at 2:30 in the Tundra!
