Remember that you have two days from the day they return to school to get those notes submitted!

When you have a question about your child's progress or a situation that happens in class, it is incredibly important to contact the teacher first to get more information. It is hard to resolve a concern if the parent and teacher do not communicate first. In almost every situation, the first step that the administrator handling an issue is going to take is facilitating a conversation between the parent and the teacher.
