### *Principal's Message September 29, 2023*

Recently, there have been multiple events on our campus that have escalated from horseplay to confrontation. I made an announcement to the student body this week to remind them that they need to keep their hands off of each other, even if they think that they are playing around. Shadow boxing is not allowed on campus. Students will receive disciplinary consequences for this behavior. Students who participate in any kind of inappropriate behavior in bathrooms, including the recording of these activities, will receive significant disciplinary consequences. I expect this behavior to stop immediately! I would appreciate it if you would take some time out this weekend to talk with your student about making good decisions and not allowing peer pressure to pull them into these types of situations, because they usually do not end well.

I would also like to remind our parents that students may not be dropped off in the student parking lot or on the bus ramp in the back of campus. Students are only allowed to be dropped off in the front parking lot that you enter closest to the marquee. It is important that we all work together to keep our students and staff safe, and we are having some issues with parents who don't want to follow our safety protocols. I do not want to trespass parents from campus, but failure to comply with our safety protocols and expectations can result in this. I know that we have a lot of people on campus and appreciate all of you who work with us to try to make sure we get everyone on and off campus safely!

Before a Hagerty student can purchase a ticket for a non-Hagerty guest, we must have an approved guest form completed. Guest forms can be found on the grade level eCampus pages under "announcements". Once forms are approved, Hagerty students will need to go into the cafeteria during their assigned lunch and purchase the ticket in-person with cash or checks only. Checks need to be made payable to "Hagerty High School".
