- All juniors and seniors who have a cumulative high school GPA of 3.75 or above and are a current Varsity student-athlete or completed the preceding two (2) Varsity seasons as a student-athlete may apply for admission to the HHS CHAPTER OF THE NAHS.
- For those students who meet the GPA requirement and sports eligibility, application forms can be found on the school website or from the athletic department.
- Admission is not automatic. In addition to having the required GPA, applicants must demonstrate significant accomplishment and/or participation in all areas indicated on the application form. It is necessary to have some accomplishments in each area.
- Make sure your application is neat and legible.
- A recommendation from your coach is required.
- Behavior and academic violations are a breach of the national bylaws, and are grounds for the denial of the application.
- Must be an active member of the HHS Athletic Booster Club \$25 due at the time of induction.
- Your application must be turned into the athletic department by Wednesday, Oct. 4th, 2023.

PLEASE NOTE: This Honor Society is a service organization. Membership is a highly sought after honor, but it requires commitment to the ideals of the organization. Your acceptance of membership will indicate your willingness to participate in HHS Athletic Booster Club sponsored activities (one each semester – Poinsettias / Golf Tournament Support), an NAHS school service project per school year, and attend bi-monthly meetings. To maintain membership in NAHS, you must maintain your GPA, fulfill your service project, be a servant leader, show good character and abide by the National Athletic Honor Society bylaws. Failure to comply with these requirements will result in dismissal from the National Athletic Honor Society. If your behavior in school requires disciplinary action, your membership may be revoked.

Your application will be based on the following criteria. Please make sure you include all the information listed on the application. Failure to do so, will automatically disqualify you for acceptance into NHS.

Academics:

Students will have earned a minimum weighted cumulative GPA of $\frac{3.75}{3.75}$ to be eligible to apply for the NAHS membership. You must maintain a $\frac{3.75}{3.75}$ GPA to stay active with the society.

Service:

- You will be required to help in some capacity with Athletic Booster Club sponsored activities (one per semester) such as Poinsettias and the Golf Tournament.
- You will be asked to participate in one in-school service project per school year. Last year, the organization collected Hygiene products for the HHS community.

*All applicants must be given a final recommendation from their coaches. The coaches will be given a recommendation checklist based on the following criteria and the **5 Core Beliefs of the NAHS**: **Good Citizenship, Sportsmanship, Competition, Moral Character and Friendship.**

Athletic Participation:

Current student-athlete or successfully completed participation in the previous year.

Such criteria is based on a willingness to help others, accountability for his/her own actions, promotes fairness, motivates others to work hard, exemplifies athletic and academic integrity, wants the best for each teammate and is loyal and trustworthy to his/her teammates.
